**Restore to me the joy of your salvation
and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.**

-Psalm 51:12

RESTORE - RENEW - RESPOND

So much has been missed over the past year when it comes to human interaction. How many handshakes and hugs have been missed? How many grandparent laps have gone un-sat-upon? A friendly wave is no comparison to a comforting embrace. The word “restore” implies that it is something that King David once had and needed to recover. To restore can mean “to bring back into a normal or former condition.” He doesn’t ask God to return his salvation, he hadn’t lost it, but he asks for joy. “Restore unto me the joy”... no one ever recovers lost joy until there is a request for its return.

Note several things about this request. First, it is an earnest request; he meant business with God. Second, it is an expectant request; he would never ask God to restore his joy if he did not believe that God would do it. Third, it is an expressive request. David knew his joy was gone. He did not deny the reality of his condition. It expresses what he knew about his inner life. He had lost his fellowship and joy of his relationship with God.

In this season of uncertainty and unwarranted loss, we are called as God's children to count the blessings of God's undeniable presence in our lives. Amid points of conflict, we read that Jesus heals and touches people. Where others might have been hands-off, Jesus was most certainly hands-on, offering a healing touch – a touch of grace. As the Church of Christ, we are to replicate these acts of love for in doing so we rediscover, replenish, and restore our joy!

Our stewardship campaign is in full swing and we will begin discerning as a community of faith our commitment to Christ and the church. Soon you will receive pledge cards with the hope that you will restore your joy, renew your commitment, and respond to God's call of worship and service.

que un espíritu obediente me sostenga.**

-Salmo 51:12

RESTAURAR-RENOVAR-RESPONDER

Se ha echado mucho de menos durante el último año en lo que respecta a la interacción humana. ¿Cuántos apretones de manos y abrazos se han perdido? ¿Cuántas vueltas de abuelos no se han sentado? Una ola amistosa no se compara con un abrazo reconfortante. La palabra "restaurar" implica que es algo que el rey David tuvo una vez y necesitaba recuperar. Restaurar puede significar "devolver a una condición normal o anterior". No le pide a Dios que le devuelva su salvación, no la había perdido, pero pide gozo. "Vuélveme el gozo" ... nadie recupera el gozo perdido hasta que haya una petición de que se lo devuelva.

Tenga en cuenta varias cosas sobre esta solicitud. Primero, es una solicitud sincera; hablaba en serio con Dios. En segundo lugar, es una solicitud expectante; nunca le pediría a Dios que le devolviera el gozo si no creyera que Dios lo haría. En tercer lugar, es una solicitud expresiva. David sabía que su gozo se había ido. No negó la realidad de su condición. Expresa lo que sabía sobre su vida interior. Había perdido el compañerismo y el gozo de su relación con Dios.

En esta temporada de incertidumbre y pérdida injustificada, somos llamados como hijos de Dios a contar las bendiciones de la innegable presencia de Dios en nuestras vidas. En medio de puntos de conflicto, leemos que Jesús sana y toca a las personas. Donde otros podrían haber estado sin manos, Jesús ciertamente fue práctico, ofreciendo un toque sanador, un toque de gracia. Como Iglesia de Cristo, debemos replicar estos actos de amor porque, al hacerlo, redescubrimos, reponemos y restauramos nuestro gozo.

Nuestra campaña de mayordomía está en pleno apogeo y comenzaremos a discernir como comunidad de fe nuestro compromiso con Cristo y la iglesia. Pronto recibirá tarjetas de compromiso con la esperanza de restaurar su gozo, renovar su compromiso y responder al llamado de adoración y servicio de Dios.





THE NORTH PLAINFIELD/PLAINFIELD'S 49TH CROP WALK

Our community believes in ending hunger. And, in 2021, we will continue to fight against the additional challenges of disease and disaster that leave people hungry. Join with us in raising funds to help neighbors near and far get the meals they need this year.

Due to COVID-19, the 2021 Plainfield/North Plainfield CROP Hunger Walk will be virtual to keep each other safe and healthy while serving our local and global neighbors. Walk anytime the week before or the week after the originally scheduled Walk date of October 31. Walkers choose when they walk, where they walk and with whom they walk! Walk alone, with immediate family or in small groups at a safe distance.

Walkers are encouraged to wear a t-shirt from a previous CROP Hunger Walk. Take a picture and post it on your Facebook page and Nuevas Fronteras' Facebook page. Let's see who can wear the oldest CROP t-shirt!
